We currently run a large grocery store at 349 Victoria Road on the south-side of Glasgow, grow fruit and vegetables across three sites in and around Glasgow, and provide veg boxes to over over 750 households per week as well as delivering to other shops, cafes and restaurants.

We also help new growers get started through our Grow the Growers programme and help those facing food poverty through our Good Food Fund.

About this role and what we're looking for:

Since opening our new store we have been much busier than expected so are looking to grow our retail/cafe team.

Experience of working in a similar retail environment or cafe/deli is pretty important. Sharing our social mission and being really into our ethos of shaping more sustainable food systems is an absolute must.

You will need is to be an adaptable problem solver who is always looking for ways to improve what they are doing, and how it is done. You're not going to have a really clear role from day one so you will need to be comfortable with this and able to learn new tasks quickly and run with it. We have a pretty flat structure so you will be expected to use a lot of initiative right away and take on further responsibilities over time both on the shop floor and in the back office.

We're also keen to talk to folk who have other specialised skills that they could be put to good use at Locavore including experience of marketing, graphic design, setting up systems, managing H&S, or programming.
